<p>Ali'iōlani Hale</p> <p>417 South King Street Honolulu, HI 96813</p>	<p>Honolulu - the name means <i>sheltered bay</i>. Older names for the harbor area are Kou and Māmala. Honolulu is an ahupua'a in the Kona district of O'ahu.</p> <p>The courthouse is named in honor Kamehameha V who authorized the construction of the building.</p>
<p>Kapuāiwa Hale</p> <p>426 Queen Street Honolulu, HI 96813</p>	<p>Honolulu - the name means <i>sheltered bay</i>. Older names for the harbor area are Kou and Māmala. Honolulu is an ahupua'a in the Kona district of O'ahu.</p> <p>The building is named in honor of Kamehameha V (Kapuāiwa is one of his names).</p>

<p>First Circuit – O‘ahu</p> <p>Ka‘ahumanu Hale 777 Punchbowl Street Honolulu, HI 96813</p>	<p>Honolulu - the name means <i>sheltered bay</i>. Older names for the harbor area are Kou and Māmala. Honolulu is an ahupua‘a in the Kona district of O‘ahu.</p>
<p>First Circuit Court - Family Court</p> <p>Ronald T.Y. Moon Kapolei Courthouse 4675 Kapolei Parkway Kapolei, HI 96707</p>	<p>Kapolei - the name means <i>beloved Kapo</i> (a sister of Pele). Kapolei is part of the ahupua‘a of Hono‘uli‘uli in the ‘Ewa district of O‘ahu.</p>
<p>Honolulu District Court</p> <p>Kauikeaouli Hale 1111 Alakea Street Honolulu, HI 96813</p>	<p>Honolulu - the name means <i>sheltered bay</i>. Older names for the harbor area are Kou and Māmala. Honolulu is an ahupua‘a in the Kona district of O‘ahu.</p>
<p>‘Ewa-Pearl City Division</p> <p>870 Fourth Street Pearl City, HI 96782</p>	<p>Mānana (older name) - the name means <i>buoyant</i>. Mānana (Pearl City) is part of the ahupua‘a of Waipahu in the ‘Ewa district of O‘ahu.</p>
<p>Kāne‘ohe Division</p> <p>Abner Pākī Hale 45-939 Po‘okela Street Kāne‘ohe, HI 96744</p>	<p>Kāne‘ohe - the name means <i>bamboo man</i>. Kāne‘ohe is an ahupua‘a in the Ko‘olaupoko district of O‘ahu.</p>
<p>Wahiawā Division</p> <p>1034 Kilani Avenue Wahiawā, HI 96786</p>	<p>Wahiawā - the name means <i>the place of the wā people</i> (a type of menehune). Wahiawā is an ahupua‘a that traditionally spanned two districts of O‘ahu - Wai‘anae and Waialua.</p>
<p>Wai‘anae Division</p> <p>4675 Kapolei Parkway Kapolei, HI 96707</p>	<p>Wai‘anae - the name means <i>mullet water</i>. Wai‘anae is an ahupua‘a in the Wai‘anae district of O‘ahu. The court, however, is located in Kapolei.</p>

Second Circuit Courthouses (Maui, Moloka'i, and Lāna'i)

Courthouse	Place Name and Ahupua'a
<p>Second Circuit - Maui, Moloka'i, and Lāna'i</p> <p>Hoapili Hale 2145 Main Street Wailuku, HI 96793</p>	<p>Wailuku - the name means destructive water. It is the sight of the famous battle between Kalani'ōpu'u and Kahekili. Wailuku is an ahupua'a in the Wailuku district of Maui.</p>
<p>Lahaina District Court</p> <p>1870 Honoapi'ilani Hwy. Lahaina, HI 96761</p>	<p>Lahaina (ancient name Lāhainā or Lele) - the name means <i>cruel sun</i>. The courthouse is located in the ahupua'a of Hanaka'ō'ō in the Lahaina district of Maui.</p>
<p>Lāna'i District Court</p> <p>730 Lāna'i Ave, #131 Lāna'i City, HI 96763</p>	<p>Lāna'i - the name means <i>day of conquest</i>. The courthouse is in the ahupua'a of Pālāwai in the Kona district of Lāna'i.</p>
<p>Moloka'i District Court</p> <p>(P.O. Box 284), 55 Makaena Street Kaunakakai, HI 96748</p>	<p>Moloka'i - the island is known as the <i>child of Hina</i>. The courthouse is in the ahupua'a of Kaunakakai in the Kona district of Moloka'i.</p>

Third Circuit Courthouses (Island of Hawai'i)

Courthouse	Place Name and Ahupua'a
<p>Third Circuit Court – Hilo</p> <p>Hale Kaulike 777 Kīlauea Avenue Hilo, HI 96720</p>	<p>Hale Kaulike - the name literally means courthouse. The courthouse is in the ahupua'a of Waiākea in the Hilo district of Hawai'i.</p>
<p>Third Circuit Court – Kona</p> <p>Keahuolū Courthouse 74-5451 Kamaka'eha Ave Kona, HI 96740</p>	<p>The name honors the ahupua'a in which the new courthouse is located - Keahuolū. Keahuolū is in the Kona district of Hawai'i.</p>
<p>Kona District Court</p> <p>79-1020 Haukapila Street Kealakekua, HI 96750</p>	<p>The courthouse is in the ahupua'a of Kealakekua in the Kona district of Hawai'i.</p>
<p>District Court Kohala Hema</p> <p>Waimea Civic Center Park at Kamuela 67-5187 Kamāmalu Street Kamuela, HI 96743</p>	<p>The courthouse is located in the moku or district of Kohala in the ahupua'a of Waimea.</p>

Fifth Circuit Courthouse (Kaua'i and Ni'ihau)

Courthouse	Place Name and Ahupua'a
<p>Fifth Circuit Court – Kaua'i and Ni'ihau</p> <p>Pu'uhonua Kaulike Hale 3970 Ka'ana Street Līhu'e, HI 96766</p>	<p>Līhu'e is located in the moku or district of Puna. The older name for this place is Kala'iamea. <i>Pu'uhonua</i> means sanctuary or place of refuge and <i>Kaulike</i> refers to justice.</p>
